



The best preparation for painting or glazing on wood is a good primer. It achieves an optimal foundation and reduces absorption to a uniform level over the whole surface area. It thereby ensures good adhesion of the subsequent coating. Selection of the right primer depends on the type of wood:

Particularly wooden elements on houses, such as façades, gables or car ports, require protection: temperature fluctuations and water affect wood so badly that moisture gets in and the wood swells, then in dry periods it contracts again. This results in the natural material becoming porous, pale and forming cracks which allow moisture in.

Besides the water-soluble “Aqua” woodstain, AURO also still offers the “Classic” range. The Classic woodstain contains natural orange oil as a solvent, which explains the typical citrus fragrance.

This should be used for renovating old Classic coats. Brushes should be cleaned with AURO Thinner no. 191.

This is the only way to prevent damage to the wood due to sun, rain and everyday use. And not only does the furniture get a water and dirt-repellent coating, but the product also restores the glorious colour of the wood. The oil pigmentation protects the garden furniture from fading due to UV light.

You can choose from water-thinnable, dark brown coloured **Aqua oil** or **Classic oils** containing solvents in various wood shades.
